Notice of Privacy Practices**

At Internal Medicine/Richard Gobao, M.D., LLC, we are committed to protecting the privacy of your medical information, as federal and state laws require. When we say information, we mean health, treatment, or payment information that identifies you. Attached is a "Notice of Privacy Practice." The notice explains how we meet this commitment. The notice also explains your legal rights about what is in your health record. All people and places that make up IM/RGMDLLC must follow this notice. This summary tells you in brief what the notice says. Please note that this summary is not a complete listing of how we use and disclose your health information. IM/RGMDLLC has the right to change this summary and the notice without first notifying you.

We may use in share your information to:

1. Provide you with medical treatment and other services.
2. Receive payment from you, a insurance company, or someone else for services, which we provide to you
3. Contact you for appointment reminders
4. Comply with the law
5. Meet special situations as described in the notice such as public health safety and research.

\*\*\*Exception: This is does not include behavioral health, drug and alcohol, & AIDS/HIV information.

Your legal rights about your health information are:

1. The right to ask to see and copy your medical record.
2. The right to ask that incorrect or incomplete information in your medical record be corrected.
3. The right to ask for list of non IM/RGMDLLC parties with whom we have shared your health information. This right does not include the health information we shared (1) if we had your written permission to share information and (2) carryout treatment payment, and other healthcare operations.

With your written agreement, IM/RGMDLLC can: Adenitis of

\*all other uses and sharing of your health information will be done only with, your specific written permission or as required by law.
